### Submission Requirements

1. Each person making a submission must pay a \$50 fee. Individuals may make a joint submission. However, each individual must pay the \$50 fee. Each submitter must be named.
2. Subject to (a) above, no submission fee is required from anyone who made a submission when the applications were first published on October 23, 2013.

The 19 applicants are taxi companies licensed by the Vancouver International Airport (YVR) Authority to provide service at YVR. On [October 23, 2013](#), the Board published applications from these companies to replace metered rates with zone rates for service originating from YVR and terminating in Richmond and Vancouver.

During the application process, the applicants submitted revised rates to the PT Board. The Board approved zone rates for YVR. The approved rates were based on the revised rates; although with some variations. The revised rates were not published.

The Board's decision was published in the Weekly Bulletin on [March 26, 2014](#).

As a result of a reconsideration request, the Board Chair directed that the applications be republished with the revised rates submitted by the applicants to the Board on March 4, 2014. There is a 7 day period for submissions. After the submission/reply period ends, the Board will reconsider the decision. The Board may confirm, vary or rescind the decision.
