We have updated our list of licensees with a Special Authorization. Licensees are listed by “category” and grouped by regional district. We have included more detailed information about vehicles and vehicle types. We have four categories:

1. Taxis
2. Limousines
3. Inter-city Buses
4. Shuttles

Our goal is to update the lists twice a year.
