1. Industry Updates & Advisories

The PSB Streamlined Application Package is not available after August 28, 2015. To apply under the [streamlined application package](#) you must have:

- ✓ held a Passenger Transportation Licence with a General Authorization on February 27, 2015,
- ✓ provided a passenger directed service, and
- ✓ operated vehicles with primarily perimeter seating that seat a driver and 12 or more passenger at any time between March 1, 2013 and March 1, 2015.
