For the 'festive season' later this year, taxi companies in BC can apply for Festive Season Temporary Operating Permits (TOPs) and choose any 30-day period between December 1 and January 15.

Peak Season TOPs for Limousines-Festive Season

Peak Season Temporary Operating Permits (PS TOPs) enables limousine operators to meet cyclical demands or seasonal demands when additional vehicles are needed on a temporary and urgent basis.
