

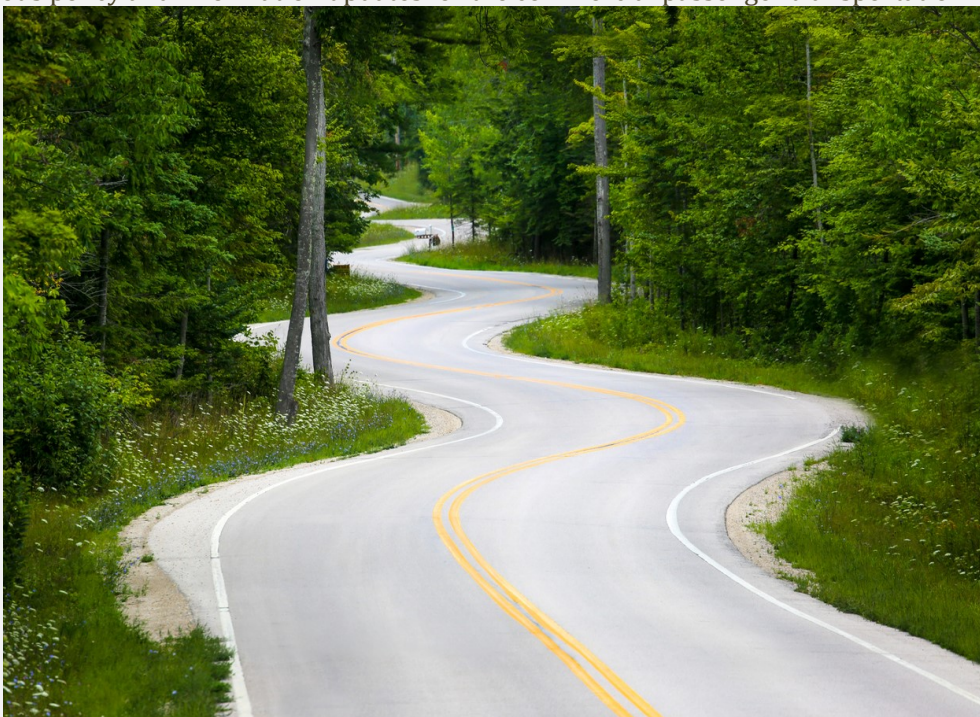

2020 TLCI
