## Board Sets Training and Other Requirements for Safety Monitors on Perimeter Seating Buses (“Party Buses”)

The Passenger Transportation (PT) Board is setting requirements for training and criminal record checks requirements of Safety Monitors required on perimeter seating buses, or PSBs— “party buses” and large “stretch limos”— when unaccompanied minors are onboard. The requirements are posted on the Board’s [limo safety webpage](#) in its new PSB Safety Monitor Rule.

Licensees that operate PSBs are responsible for ensuring that the training and record-check requirements are met. Safety monitors must obtain certifications that meet minimum first aid training requirements that include CPR, automated external defibrillation and Naloxone. They must also receive pre-service training in safety requirements and procedures.

New PT Board training and record-check requirements take effect April 1, 2019. They are in addition to recent [PSB safety requirements in the Passenger Transportation Regulation](#) (sections 12.2 – 12.4) that PSB licensees are responsible for adhering to—requirements that include parental consent forms for unaccompanied minors.

Within a year, the PT Board will review requirements in the PSB Safety Monitor Rule and, with input from PSB licensees and other stakeholders, consider adjustments or clarifications that would improve the Rule.
