Updates & Enhancements for Taxi Camera Programs

The PT Board has consolidated taxi camera requirements into one rule. It also published new info sheets. These changes simplify taxi camera programs and enhance their effectiveness. Four new documents are posted at the Board's [taxi camera webpage](#):

- BC Taxi Camera Rule (three rules consolidated into one)
- Taxi Camera Info for Passengers (updated)
- Taxi Camera Info for Drivers (new)
- Taxi Camera Info for Taxi Companies (new)

The documents are for established taxi camera programs in Greater Vancouver, Greater Victoria, Prince George and Williams Lake. They are also for companies that plan to start a taxi camera program.

The Board strongly encourages taxi companies to invest in the safety of its drivers. There are a few ways to do this. In particular, taxi cameras have been shown to reduce serious attacks against drivers.

Starting a taxi camera program in BC takes four administrative steps. See Appendix D of the BC Taxi Camera Rule for details. Or, call the Board office at 250-953-3777 to learn more about the use of taxi cameras in BC.
