

## I. Background

- The Board uses its Taxi & Limousine Cost Index (TLCI) as an objective measurement for identifying rate increase for taxis. TLCI uses Consumer Price Index (CPI) data for BC that is obtained from Statistics Canada. Details are posted at <https://www.ptboard.bc.ca/tlci.htm>.
- On July 29, 2020, the Board approved the “Taxi Cost & Limousine Cost Index 2020” rule that implements a taxi rate increase of 2.3% for licensed taxi operators in British Columbia.

## II. Rates for Taxicab Companies

The following rates and taxi meter formula must be implemented on **September 1, 2020**:

Flag	2.7886	2.9281	2.95	\$2.95 for the first 44.94 metres
Distance (per km)	2.1194	2.2253	2.23	\$0.10 for each additional 44.94 metres
Wait Time (hourly)	44.6183	46.8492	46.85	\$0.10 for each consecutive 7.68 seconds (or \$46.8492 per hour)
