

1. Background

- ◆ The Passenger Transportation Act allows the Board to: (a) set rates for the purpose of establishing just and uniform charges and; (b) to make rules governing how rates may be charged or applied.
- ◆ [Standard Rules for Taxicab Rates](#) apply to rates that are charged by taxicabs in British Columbia. Under section 10, the Board may approve additional, company-specific rules.

2. Additional Rules for Prince George Licensees

a. Volume Discounts

When an established charge account customer provides revenue of \$2,500 per month or greater, the amount to be billed will be reduced by 5%.

3. Applicability

Licensees: Prince George Taxi Licensees (See Appendix A of the Board Rule Respecting Prince George Taxicab Rates.)
