

## 2026 TLCI Request for Taxis PT Board Form 22

Use this form if you are a metered taxi licensee operating within [Passenger Transportation Region 1 and/or 2](#), requesting a 2026 Taxi & Limousine Cost Index (TLCI) increase of up to 3.92% in your taxi rates. The deadline for requesting a 2026 TLCI increase is **July 3, 2026**.

*Note:* In Passenger Transportation Region 1, where taxis have common rates, licensees with 51% of the taxis must request an increase for it to be applied to all licensees in the area. In Passenger Transportation Region 2, at least 51% of licensees must request the increase.

## Pending Increase in Taxi Rates

This letter notifies local government that \_\_\_\_\_ is asking the Passenger Transportation Board to implement a \_\_\_\_\_ % increase in its taxi rates.

Our request is based on a decision of the Board to allow taxi companies to request a 2026 Taxi and Limousine Cost Index (TLCI) increase of up to 3.92% for taxis. The decision is based on CPI B.C. data from July 2023 to December 2023 (152.48) and the average CPI from January 2025 to December 2025 (158.46) to determine an average CPI increase of 3.92%.
